The 24th Annual Oregon Trail Days International Food Fair



Be a part of the 2010 Oregon Trail Days Annual Food Fair on Friday, July 16. You'll have the chance to dazzle as many as 7,000 people with your culinary skills and generate income for your organization or business.

This year's event will run from 5 to 8 p.m. in the heart of beautiful downtown Gering. Set up begins at 3 p.m.

Oregon Trail Days vendor permits and city vending permits will not be honored for this event only. Your application below is your permit.

Electricity for your booth will be provided by the city of Gering and will be limited to 1500 watts of 110-volt power per booth with few exceptions. Each vendor will have access to two outlets only. All vendors cooking on-site will be required to have at their booth a working 10 lb. or larger, ABC fire extinguisher.

Each vendor will be required to have a free-standing covering over their serving area. Tent pegs or stakes are prohibited. This year, the Oregon Trail Day's committee will not be renting tents and each vendor will be required to assemble and take down their own.

Permit Fees are:

- ♦ **Non-profit organizations** **\$50**
(These are Church Groups and Scout Groups only)
- ♦ **All Other Organizations** **\$110**
