

OREGON TRAIL HILL CLIMB TIME TRIAL

Scottsbluff National Monument, Gering, NE
Saturday, July 17, 2010 7:00 AM

REGISTRATION: Race day registration will close promptly 15 minutes prior to race start
ENTRY FEE: \$20.00. Make checks payable to Oregon Trail Days

1. The course is a 1.6 mile hill climb with an average grade of 5%.
2. Riders will depart at 1 minute intervals unless otherwise announced.
3. The order of start will be determined by bib number without regard to classification or category.
4. Helmets must be worn at all times when you are on the bike; this includes warm-up. Failure to do so will result in immediate disqualification with no refund of registration fee.
5. The course will not be open to warm-up prior to the start of the event. It is suggested that stationary trainers be used in the parking area for warm-up.
6. Riders will not be allowed to ride down the course once they have completed the competition. Support vehicles to bring riders down must depart to the top of the monument 10 minutes prior to the start of the event. Support vehicles will be allowed to park only in the designated parking area at the top of the course.
7. A limit of 90 riders will be in effect.

This entry blank and release form is a contract with legal consequences. Read it carefully before you sign.

In consideration of the acceptance of my application for entry into the Oregon Trail Hill Climb, I hereby freely agree and make the following contracted representations and agreements.

I fully realize the dangers of participating in a bicycle race and fully assume the risks associated with such participation including, by way of example and not limitation, the following; the dangers of collision with pedestrians, vehicles, other racers, and fixed or moving objects; the dangers arising from surface hazards, equipment failure, inadequate safety equipment, and weather conditions; the possibility of serious physical and/or mental trauma or injury associated with athletic cycling competition.

I hereby waive, release, and discharge myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, assigns, and successors in interest (hereinafter collectively "successors") any and all rights and claims which I have or which may hereafter accrue to me against the sponsors of this event, the National Park Service, the promoter and any promoting organization(s), property owners, law enforcement agencies, all public entities, special districts, and properties (and their respective agents, officials, and employees) through or by which the events will be held for any and all damages which may be sustained by me directly or indirectly in connection with, or arising out of, my participation in or association with the event, or travel to or return from the event.

I agree it is my sole responsibility to be familiar with the race course and any special regulations for the event. I understand and agree that situations may arise during the event which may be beyond the immediate control; of the race officials or organizers, and I must continually ride so as to neither endanger myself or others. (I will compete wearing a helmet that can protect against serious head injury, and assume a responsibility and liability for the selection of such a helmet.) I have no physical or mental condition which, to my knowledge, would endanger myself or others if I participate in this event, or would interfere with my ability to participate in this event. I agree, for myself and successors, that the above representation are contractually binding, and are not mere recitals, and that should I or my successors assert my claim in contravention of this agreement, I or my successors shall be liable for the expenses (including legal fees) incurred by the other party or parties in defending, unless the other party or parties are finally adjudged liable on such claim for willful and wanton negligence. This agreement may not be modified orally, and a waiver of any provision shall not be construed as a modification of any other provision herein or as consent to any subsequent waiver or modification.

Parent or legal guardian of a Minor child; I as parent or legal guardian of the below named minor, hereby give my permission for my child or ward to participate in this event, and further agree, individually and on behalf of my child or ward, to the terms on the front of this document.
