Rule # 2 Throwing of anything or squirring of any fluids into the crowd from any entry will not be permitted along the parade route. Violations will result in the immediate removal of that unit, and that unit will forfeit all prizes that they may have been awarded.

Rule # 3 All vehicle entrants must be a **Pre-1964 Vintage**
Pull vehicles are exempt from this rule.

Rule # 4 No parade participant will be allowed to get off or on the float or entry while on the parade route.

A copy of this rules signed by the responsible person in charge of the entry must be in the possession of the parade committee before the entry is allowed on the parade route.
